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## Purpose of Role

The Match Day Nurse is a volunteer position. The main purpose of this role is to assist the Match Day Doctor and satisfy any player medical requirements at the Tournament Venue.

## Key Areas of Responsibility

- General nursing duties
- Set-up of the Match Day Medical Room as per the doctors' directions
- Assist Match Day Doctors with suturing as required
- Ensure cleanliness and tidiness within the Match Day Medical Room

## Key Outcomes

- Injured players are given appropriate medical attention as prescribed by Match Day Doctor

## Knowledge, Skills and Behaviour Required

- Enrolled Nurse (EN) and Registered Nurse (RN)
- Understanding of sports and soft tissue injuries

## Major Interactions

- Match Day Doctor
- Operations Coordinator
- Team Management and Players

## Unique Criteria

- The Match Day Nurse will be provided with a uniform (items and quantities TBC) as well as 2 General Admission tickets to each day of competition
- Meals and drinks will be provided on each day of competition as applicable
